



## Curriculum Plans Vocational Nursing Certificate of Proficiency- Level Two Divine School for Healthcare Professionals

### August to August Program

#### Program Description

This course of instruction prepares individuals to assist in providing general nursing care under the direction of a registered nurse, physician, or dentist. Includes instruction in taking patient vital signs, applying sterile dressings, administration of medication, patient health education, head to toe assessments, and assistance with examinations and treatment. Upon completion of this program, the graduate will be eligible to sit for the National Council Licensure Examination for Vocational Nurses (NCLEX-PN). After successful completion of the exam, individuals will be eligible for various employment opportunities, including positions as a staff nurse in settings such as hospitals, nursing

homes, adult day care centers, doctor's offices, dialysis centers, and correctional facilities. The Vocational Nursing program is a one-year program. Students must successfully pass every semester to continue in the program.
